

Remote GUI Shortcuts for Specific Units

In order to program individual desktop shortcuts for specific test sets, the shortcut properties need to be edited. These properties include IP Address, Login and Password.

To do this, follow these steps:

1. Right-click on the desktop's Remote NIC icon, select Copy, then right-click on the desktop and select Paste.
2. Right-click on the new icon, select Rename, and rename it to show what specific test set this new shortcut will connect to.
3. Right-click on the new icon again, and select Properties. Click in the Target field so that the mouse cursor is flashing after "...Galaxy.exe".
4. Type the following command: "ip=xxx.xxx.xxx.xxx,uid=Admin,pw=Admin1" (where xxx is the unit's IP address fields). Include the quote marks.
 - Be sure to put a space between "...Galaxy.exe" and "ip= ...". The three fields that follow are comma-delimited and do not allow spaces.
 - Note that any Login User ID and Password created from the specific NIC unit's Security tab can be used here.
5. See the illustration below for an example.
6. Click OK, and then double-click the new icon to connect to the specified unit.
7. Delete the old icon, if desired.
